Sprints visit Saturday, Speedway announces Schedule changes due to Rainout

BROCKVILLE-The always popular winged warriors return to the Beast of the East on Saturday night. North America's race car, the Sprint Car will be front and centre at Brockville Ontario Speedway for the first of three runs this season culminating with the finale of the 2009 race season in October.

The 360 Sprints will be joined on Saturday's card for a flat point night for Sportsman, along with double features for both the Vintage and Rookie classes to make up for their rained out features from last Saturday evening when the skies opened right after the heat races were completed. The green flag will drop on the triple threat Wilson clan, along with former Brockville regulars Paul Pekkonen and Tyler Rand, all of whom are aboard the ultra fast sprint cars at 7pm.

The Modifieds will be making their annual weekend sweep through Quebec, some of the Sportsman regulars will be off at a Super DIRT Series event in Weedsport New York and the street stocks will be in action as part of the Eastern Ontario Challenge at Brighton.

Next Saturday night, July 25th, will feature double features for the 358 Modifieds, Sportsman and Street Stocks to make up their feature runs from a week ago. The Rookies will run their regular feature event only. Tickets from the July 11th 50/50 draw will be continued into the draw that night as well.
