Rained Out Features completed, New Rain out features now set for August 8th

BROCKVILLE-The weather continues to play havoc with the racing season at Brockville Ontario Speedway. However, it's lady luck that seems to be riding with 8 time track champion Danny O Brien at the Beast of the East. Both Mother Nature and O Brien came out on top on Saturday night at the fast quarter mile.

The night began with rained out features from July 11th. Ryan Poole looked like he was going to win for the first time in the 30 lap 358 Modified event. Poole took the lead from the get-go and held onto it until lap 29 and three quarters. O Brien pulled alongside going into turn 3, then without a touch Poole looped the 76 car on the outside of the track, handing the Pocket Rocket his fifth win of 2009. Kyle Dingwall navigated around the spinning car for second followed by Adam Moore, Tim O Brien and John Mulder. Poole ended up 13th.

Sheldon Hoogwerf grabbed the lead early in the 25 lap Sportsman feature and held off late challenges from first Luke Whitteker and then Matt Billings before pulling away for good and scoring his first win in a couple of seasons. Billings led the teenage brigade in second followed by Whitteker and Dylan Evoy, and veteran Randy Gaudet. The Street Stocks also ran their make up feature right off the top of the night, Brock Cullen's finest season ever continued with a close feature win over Dominic Gauvreau. Cullen wrestled the top spot away around the mid point of the 15 lap affair from Danny Mocibob and then withstood multiple charges from Gauvreau who settled for second. Mocibob was third with Guy Amesse and Bill Code not far behind.

The heat races for the regularly scheduled, July 25th program were well underway with Rookie and Modified runs complete, and one Sportsman battle done and another halfway through when the predicted rain came to the track. The night is considered a complete program. However, this scenario does present another night of double features two weeks from now on August 8th in all four regular divisions for the 12 dollar admission price. Next Saturday night, August 1st, the Lucas Oil Canadian DIRT Challenge Series for 358 Modifieds comes to the Beast of the East for a 100 lap showdown. Time Trials are set for 6:30 pm with the first green flag at 7pm. O Brien, Mario Clair and David Hebert have split the first three events of the series.
