Big Blocks Blast into Brockville Thursday Night

BROCKVILLE-The top Big Block Modified drivers on the planet are ready to tangle with the Beast of the East again. Brockville Ontario Speedway will host the fourth annual trip of the Super DIRT Series to the fast quarter mile on Thursday night, July 9th. The highlight of the night will be the Coca-Cola-Bob FM 100 lap feature event, the opening race in a four event run through Eastern Ontario and Quebec.

Brett Hearn, who has a pretty solid record over the years at Brockville leads the tour heading north by an impressive 98 points. Among those looking to move up are former Brockville regular Dale Planck and defending series champ Billy Decker, who hasn't had many tours of the Brockville oval, but has been a contender with each visit. Decker took home the 6 thousand dollar payday a year ago in his potent LJL Racing number 91.

They will all have to contend with the Kingston trio. 8 time track champ and current Brockville points leader Danny O' Brien who has already visited his dog Tucker in victory lane after four races this season along with Brother Pat back off a month absence with a win in his pocket and younger sibling Tim, hot off a big win on Sunday night as well. The Iceman sent the locals home happy two years ago by getting the best of Tim Fuller in a dramatic 100 finish.

The Brockville race always attracts an excellent field of both big and small block Modifieds as both engines seem to work well on the high banked Beast of the East and contend for points. Pits open at 3 o'clock and spectators will be allowed through the main gates at 4 p.m. Integra Shocks time trials will take place at 6:30 p.m. following 5:45 warm-ups with the first heats of the night getting underway at 7 p.m. There will be a special Street Stock Invitational, 500 dollars to win event to round out the special Thursday night program.

Brockville Ontario Speedway is easily accessible from all directions: From Watertown N.Y. and south take 1-81 to Thousand Islands Bridge, exit onto Highway 401 East, follow Highway 401 East to Highway 29 at Brockville, then turn left at lights following exit follow Highway 29 to track on left; From Ottawa ON and north take Highway 417 to Highway 7, take Highway 7 west to Highway 15 at Carleton Place, follow Highway 15 South to Smith's Falls, pick up Highway 29 at light just after bridge in Smith's Falls, then follow (appox 30kms) to track on right hand side; From Kingston ON and west take Highway 401 East to Highway 29 exit at Brockville, turn left at lights, take Highway 29 13 kms North to find track on left; From Cornwall ON and east, take Highway 401 West to Highway 29 exit at Brockville, turn right at lights, take Highway 29 13 kms North and track is on the left.
