Morin wins second of year at Brockville

BROCKVILLE-Brockville Ontario Speedway has its first repeat winner in its headline division in 2010. 17 year old Gage Morin again showed the poise of a veteran as he captured his second 30 lap 358 Modified victory of the season on Steve Polite Sand and Gravel night Saturday at the Beast of the East.

Morin was challenged briefly around the midway point by Brian McDonald, who started dead last in the main event after hitting the wall in his heat. However it was no contest after the final restart as Morin cruised to another impressive win. Pat O'Brien made some nifty moves in the closing laps for third in front of John Mulder and Danny O'Brien.

A much tackier than usual race track proved to be a challenge for both the Patriot Spints and DIRT Sportsman as both their features turned into marathons. McDonald dominated the early stages of the sprint event as he did double duty on the night. His hopes came apart when he was forced off the track and into the swamp to avoid a wayward lapped car handing the win to Jared Zimbardi. Rick Wilson led the local sprint drivers with a strong fourth place run.

Randy Earl survived a series of early mishaps and then withstood a late race challenge from Dylan Evoy to grab the 20 lap Sportsman main, his first of 2010. The event was marred by incident after incident as the fast race track wasn't what many had in mind this night. Adam Turner was third with Chris Raabe using a borrowed car in fourth and Shane Pecore fifth.

Kevin Fetterly Jr, was also a first time winner in 2010 as he took the 15 lap Street Stock battle. Nick Gauvreau got as far as second but couldn't catch the 57 before the checkered flag fell. Todd Raabe, Stephane Bussiere and Brock Cullen were third through fifth respectively. Selena Simzer was involved in a wreck in turn 2 on the first lap. She was taken to hospital as a precaution with bumps and bruises after a jarring ride. Dwight Feltham dodged a lapped car and then held off a determined Jean Marc Larose for Rookie honours. Chris Lloyd was third with John Gifford and Scott Walldruf close behind.

Brockville's regular Wednesday night go kart card got rained out this week, but is back in action on June 16 at 7 pm. The big track returns to racing on Saturday night, June 19th with all four regular divisions plus the vintage cars and the very popular Mod Light tour returning to the Beast of the East. The green flag drops at 7 pm.
