Defending Champ Back in Form at Brockville

BROCKVILLE-Danny O'Brien has been the dominant force at Brockville Ontario Speedway in recent years. However, his start to the 2010 racing season had some scratching their heads. O'Brien had the rest of the field wondering what the rest of the year will be like as he returned to form on Saturday night at the Beast of the East capturing his first win of the season in the 358 Modified feature.

It was a good night to be an O'Brien period, as for the second time in Brockville history the three brothers swept all of the podium spots. While Danny was rocketing away from the field, Pat was his usual calculating self moving up smartly from 12th starting spot to second before the checkered flag. Brother Tim who led early was a solid third. Bobby Herrington was fourth with Stephane LaFrance nursing a battered 115 car across the line in fifth.

Chris Raabe flexed his muscle again in the 25 lap Sportsman event, despite starting deep in the 27 car field, he had the 01 car in fourth before a handful of laps were complete. Raabe finally got past an very impressive Josh Kane on a mid race restart and pulled away for his fourth win of the year. Chris Herbison was third, followed by Jessica Power, with her best Sportsman run yet in fourth and a hard charging Randy Earl in fifth.

The Mod Lites made their annual visit to Brockville for a special 25 lap affair. Scott Billing had them all covered early until he spun in turn four. Jason Corless had no where to go and flipped several times resulting in a precautionary trip to the hospital. Paul Klager took advantage of the mayhem in front of him to grab the win after a good back and forth dual with Adam Murphy. Ray Sliter was third.

Kevin Fetterly made it two in a row in the Street Stock division with a very smooth drive in the 15 lap feature. Brock Cullen nipped Brian Billings at the line for second with Derrick Eaton and Steve Kearney rounding out the fast five. Jean Marc Larose took the lead when Josh Kirkland missed a shift on a restart and cruised from there to another Rookie feature win. Joe McNichols was second in front of Dwight Feltham, John Gifford and Scott Walldruff. Wayne Riddell scored top spot in the 12 lap Vintage event holding off Cole Dingwall at the checkered flag. Jason Powers, John Gibson and Denzil Billings Jr, were third through fifth respectively.

For the second straight week, Brockville's go kart track was idle due to another rainy Wednesday. They will try again on June 23rd. Brockville Ontario

Speedway returns to action, next Saturday night, June 26th for Luna Pizzeria Night at the track. All four base classes will be in action along with the always popular Spectator Bag Race. The green flag drops at 7 pm.
