Sportsman Super DIRT Series coming to Brockville

BROCKVILLE-The racing season is already a month and half old at Brockville Ontario Speedway. It's time to turn up the heat at the Beast of the East starting next Saturday night, July 4th with the first Super DIRT Series event of 2009 at the fast quarter mile high banked oval. The young guns of the DIRT, the Sportsman division will make their annual series appearance at the speedway.

It will be part of a busy week for the Sportsman regulars with four races in as many days including the July 4th battle in Brockville. Defending champion of both the Brockville tour stop and the Sportsman Super DIRT Series, Chris Raabe of Napanee leads the series heading into the busy week of action. However, two drivers with Brockville wins already this season are close behind in Brockville's new teenage sensation, Broadway Matt Billings and Sammy Reakes. Billings is just 24 points back in third with Reakes a strong fourth just two behind Broadway Matt with another Brockville regular, the popular Adam Turner in sixth spot in the overall DIRT standings. They'll be challenged by Brockville point leader, yet another teenager Shane Pecore who sits 2 points ahead of Billings on the home front.

The Super DIRT series event for the Sportsman presented by Brockville Motors will be a 40 lap affair on a super bill that also includes the 358 Modifieds, Street Stocks, Rookies and Vintage cars also in action beginning at 7pm. Just five days later on July 9th, the Super DIRT series will descend on the Beast of the East for the 4th Annual Advance Auto Parts event for Big Block Modifieds making it a busy week at the BOS. Brockville Ontario Speedway is located just north of Brockville just off Regional Road 29.
