Teenager Evoy regains his touch at Brockville

BROCKVILLE-It didn't take Brockville's Dylan Evoy long to find victory lane for the first time in Stock Car Racing career. The talented teenager won a feature in his rookie season after a star studded career in go karts. However, the wait for the second win was a little longer as the 16 year old went winless in 2008 at Brockville Ontario Speedway.

The slump came to an end on Saturday night as Evoy dominated from the mid point of the 25 lap Sportsman event going on to take an impressive victory in a caution filled affair. Evoy was able to hold off Sheldon Hoogwerf in the final 3 lap dash to the checkered. Matt Billings was third just edging across the line in front of Shane Pecore and Dave Wilgosh. Evoy's key to the win was being able to run the top groove to perfection.

That same groove was the ticket just minutes before for Kingston's Danny O Brien. O Brien made it two in a row to start the season at the Beast of the East in the 358 Modified division as he scored a convincing triumph in his new Global Warranty Bicknell. O Brien started 14th in the 22 car field but just kept blasting by people on the outside of the track finally knocking off first Todd Stewart and then Kyle Dingwall to take the top spot for good. Stewart also eventually got past Dingwall for second with Bill Gill and Tim O Brien rounding out the top five.

Brock Cullen went wire to wire in the 15 lap Street Stock main on Kemptville Truck Centre night despite a late charge from teammate and friend Steve Billings who settled for second for the second week in a row. Kevin Fetterly Jr., Stephane Bussiere and Bill Code were third through fifth respectively. Gerry Oszczakiewicz picked up where he left off a week ago taking his second straight Rookie event after briefly losing the top spot on the final lap to Steve Barber and then grabbing it back when the two cars tangled in turn 2. Chris Bakker ended up second with Benoit Laroche and Ronnie Tyo in tow with Barber 5th.

Brockville Ontario Speedway will try again on Wednesday night to kick off the 2009 go kart season at 7pm. The next event at the big track comes next Saturday night, June 6th with Luna Pizzeria night with all four regular classes in action plus the vintage cars. The pre race show goes at 615 with the first green flag at 7pm.
