Next Stop Season Opener

BROCKVILLE-It will be an equal playing field when cars hit the track at Brockville Ontario Speedway on Saturday night, May 15th at 7 pm for opening night. No one was able to get in some practice laps during the scheduled test and tune this weekend as a parapluie was more appropriate than Hoosiers.

That now sets the stage for the Season Opener as the four core classes at the Beast of the East begin the battle for track titles in 2010 this coming Saturday. Danny O Brien leads the charge in the 358 Modified division as he tries once again to defend his crown yet again. One of the young guns with a mark on the cagey veteran is 2009 Sportsman champ Matt Billings as he moves up a division and starts his new quest on his 17th birthday in a special Syracuse qualifier. That leaves Shane Pecore and Dylan Evoy as the pre season favorites in the Sportsman class which may see the return of a former champ as a Brockville regular.

The Street Stocks and Rookies will also begin their weekly program appearances on Saturday. Admission for a regular show is still a very economical 12 dollars. The Beast of the East is located just north of Brockville on Highway 29. The season runs through mid October in 2010 closing with the 2nd annual DIRT Northeast Nationals.
