BROCKVILLE-Brockville Ontario Speedway is usually a pretty quiet place at this time of year. However, the Beast of the East has been busier than ever before this weekend as final preparations take place for the first ever DIRTcar Northeast Fall Nationals coming up Saturday and Sunday afternoons at the local oval. 358 Modifieds, Sportsman, Pro Stocks, Street Stocks and 360 Sprint cars will all be taking to the race track.

RVs and race trailers full of fans and race cars will start rolling into the BOS tomorrow afternoon to get ready for the largest event in 40 years of competition at the track. Everything from a stage for a Saturday night concert to extra food has been rolling in the front gates this week. Breakfast will be served both days for the early risers and local radio station BOB-Fm, 103.7 will be broadcasting live on site on Saturday morning. Up and coming country music vocalist Rebekka Paige will handle anthem duties both days as well as a 20 minute set before hot laps on both days of the event. A live band is scheduled to take the stage after Saturday's racing program is complete.

On track activity starts at noon on Saturday when the 360 sprint cars put some heat in their engines followed by the Locke Truss pre race show featuring local fan favourite April Wilson and a sprint car panel including Canada's premier voice of the sprints Greg Calnan, an Eastern Ontario native.

Qualifying for the Super DIRT Series races for both 358 Modifieds and Sportsman will roll off at 1:15 followed by Heat races beginning at 2pm. Sunday will see the pre race show start things off at 12:30 with hot laps getting underway at 1:25 followed by qualifying for the Super DIRT Series Pro Stock tour and heats and last chance races for the Modifieds, Street Stocks and Pro Stocks commencing at 2pm.
