### Small Block Stars Return to the BOS Saturday

BROCKVILLE-The Super DIRT Series makes it's annual early September run at the Brockville Ontario Speedway on Saturday night, September 12th. The Jack May Pontiac sponsored event features the 358 Modified Super DIRT Series stars along with all four other Brockville regular classes in action.

The small block tour race will give 9 time Brockville track champion, Danny O'Brien a home track advantage as he tries to move up in the Mr. DIRT standings. After three events the Kingston driver is in third spot just 47 points behind former Brockville regular Dale Planck and hot on the heels of defending champ Pete Bicknell of St. Catherines, who always loves his trips to the Beast of the East.

This event will be the first of four more Super DIRT Series races to be held at Brockville this season, with Pro Stock, Sportsman, and another 358 Modified events scheduled for October 17th and 18th during the first ever Northeast Nationals. Saturday night's program gets underway with time trials for the Modifieds at 6:30 with the first heat race set for 7pm.
