Brockville regulars dominate first enduro, Renfrew takes the nightcap at Kanes Monster Day

BROCKVILLE-Brockville Ontario Speedway held its annual Kanes Towing Enduro on Sunday afternoon attracting more than 100 cars to the Beast of the East. The first event was a four and six cylinder enduro that attracted 70 cars for a 75 lap jount in the sunshine. Brockville four cylinder regular Chris Lloyd of Kingston took the lead in the final 25 lap segment after teammate Dwight Feltham of Kingston crunched into a vacant car on the front straight. Feltham recovered for a second place run with Street Stock track champ Steve Billings of Smiths Falls in third.

After cleaning up the evidence of the first enduro, more than 30 8 cylinder cars rolled onto the quarter mile for a 100 lap enduro. Darryl Steele led almost the entire distance in leading a Renfrew sweep of the top three spots. Scott Steele was around two laps behind in second place when the checkered dropped followed by Terry McClellan in third.

Brockville Ontario Speedway will reopen on October 17th and 18th for the first ever DIRT Northeast Fall Nationals, featuring an open 360 Sprint Car event and a Super DIRT Series for Sportsman event along with 358 Modified tour qualifying on Saturday. Sunday will feature Super DIRT Series events for the 358 Modifieds and Pro Stocks along with the Street Stocks. Tickets are now on sale through the track office.
